



#### 2020 Rally Marshals

Dear Centre members,

Just a note to those members who may wish to Marshal a rally in 2021. In order to avoid disappointment, would anyone who wishes to Marshal one of the events listed in the Provisional 2021 program please note the following.

In order to give everyone, the same chance you may advise me, (in advance of the Rally program meeting on Sunday 17th May at Willows Farm, Warton) your intentions, in particular where you have run the same rally for a number of years. This can be done by telephone, but must be confirmed in writing and presented by a friend at the meeting.

If more than one member wishes to marshal the same rally, a cut of playing cards will decide which member will be chosen as the marshal. (It will be Ace High, High card wins).

This is intended to give everyone an equal chance to marshal those rallies in which they are interested.

If potential marshals suggest a new venue, which they would like to run, they will be given priority at the meeting, again this should be done in writing in advance of the meeting.

I will update the provisional program with the names of those who have advised their intentions in advance.

Thanks for your help and understanding on this matter and I look forward to receiving your ideas for venues for 2021.

Furthermore, it has been decided that anyone who wishes to run a <u>Holiday Rally</u>, should also be prepared to attend a minimum of 5 South Staffs weekend rallies during the year.

Would marshals also contact the plaque officer to notify the number of plaques required, and their chosen motif. The motifs can be viewed on the FM-Tags web-site www.fm-tags.co.uk .

Also, when marshals receive an on-line booking for their rally, could they please respond to it, to let the member booking know that they are booked in.

#### CENTRE REGISTRATION.

#### Centre Registration is valid for one year only.

To continue your registration, you need to re-register through the caravan club each year regardless of how you pay your subscription. You can do this by contacting the caravan club by phone, post, or online at <a href="https://www.caravanclub.co.uk/local-groups">www.caravanclub.co.uk/local-groups</a> you can also go through the South Staffs Centre website by clicking on the Register Re-Register tab on the home page at <a href="https://www.southstaffscaravanclub.co.uk">www.southstaffscaravanclub.co.uk</a>

Unless you register with a centre you WILL NOT BE ABLE TO.

A:.....Receive any circulated information.

B:.....Be allowed to speak or vote at Centre Annual General Meetings.

C:.....Be eligible to propose any Centre member for an Officer or Committee position.

D:.....Be eligible to Marshal any South Staffs Rallies

There have been a lot of changes by the Caravan & Motorhome Club regarding the club rules, please take time to read them carefully as they affect everyone.

#### SOUTH STAFFS CENTRE RALLY RULES

- 1: Any site or part of a site, on which a rally is held, shall be for the exclusive use of Caravan & Motorhome Club member's caravans & motorhomes. Attendance at the site and/or payment of the rally fee shall be deemed acceptance by a member of these rules.
- 2: Authority for the conduct of a rally shall be vested in the Rally Marshal or his deputy.
- <u>3:</u> **ALL RALLIES** shall commence at 2.00pm on Friday unless otherwise stated in the Rally Book, or as instructed by the Rally Marshals.
- 4: All members must report to the Rally Marshal upon arrival at the site before pitching their caravan or motorhome. A member must be prepared to substantiate their identity by production of their membership card to the Rally Marshal or their deputy.
- <u>5:</u> Each caravan or motorhome and towing vehicle must be placed on the pitch indicated by the Marshal or their deputy.
- 6: ALL CARAVANS & MOTORHOMES MUST BE PITCHED WITH AT LEAST 6 METERS FROM SIDE WALL OF ONE CARAVAN/MOTORHOME TO THE NEXT. Members violating this rule can expect to be asked to move. Motor vehicles should be parked on the off side of the caravan. This rule minimises fire hazard and respects a neighbour's pitch. The Club advises all caravanners and motorhomers to carry a fire extinguisher/fire bucket this is now mandatory and must be displayed at the front of the outfit.

- <u>7:</u> Not more than one pitch may be reserved, unless approved, in advance, by the Marshal.
- 8: THE SPEED LIMIT ON THE RALLY FIELD SHALL BE WALKING PACE. Fully licensed drivers only are allowed to drive on the rally site.
- <u>9:</u> Dogs at all times must be held or tethered on a lead not exceeding 8 feet in length and tethered not more than 2 feet from any part of the caravan/motorhome. All dogs must be exercised away from the caravans/motorhomes.

Please note that no pets including dogs will be allowed at indoor social events or in the Coleman shelters.

- 10: Members must make provision to store and take home all dry and wet refuse. Empty only Chemical Toilets in the pit provided. Chemical Toilets must not be filled or washed at or near Drinking Water Supplies.
- 11: Noise must be kept to a reasonable minimum and cease at 11pm. Music and parties must not disturb neighbouring members.
- 12: The use of guns, catapults and all weapons is prohibited.
- 13: The riding of bicycles & scooters, flying of kites and model aircraft, as well as ball games is not permitted among or close to caravans/motorhomes. Parents will be held responsible for any damaged incurred.
- <u>13a</u>: Drones are banned from the Rally field and any Centre event also from any Club site without prior agreement from Head Office. Any unauthorised use by members will face disciplinary action.
- 14: To book on a rally (a) Book directly through our fully secure web site, by clicking on the relevant rally, then "book online" after which the booking form should be completed and submitted. The Marshal will acknowledge your booking and for some rallies where a deposit is required, advise the amount to be forwarded to secure the booking.
- (b) Deliver a completed booking slip to the Rally Marshal either by post or by hand.

- 15: Rally Booking Terms and Conditions. Members who cancel or do not arrive must pay £2.00 for weekend rallies or a calculated amount to cover any costs incurred prior to the rally which includes unsold social tickets. If these costs are not paid the secretary will send the member an additional invoice for £5.00 to cover additional administration costs. On limited rallies the full cost must be paid. As regards to pre-paid rallies the following may apply
- (a) If you cancel a rally due to be reavement of a close family member the Centre Committee will consider a full refund
- (b) Any cancellation up to 2 weeks (14 days) prior to the rally you will be reimbursed at 50% less any other costs incurred.
- (c) Any cancellation less than 1 week (7 days) before the rally will not be refunded (except for point (a) above). If the centre cancels a rally, all deposits are refundable.
- <u>16:</u> A Plain Red or Yellow Flag flown from the flagpole indicates that a Marshal is restricting vehicle movement on the site. Vehicles must not be moved without a marshal's permission. Other Centres including the Caravan Club may use a Yellow Flag.
- <u>17:</u> If a tow is accepted, it is on the understanding that the owner or driver of the towing vehicle shall not be held responsible for any damage incurred. Persons accepting a tow from a 4X4 vehicle do so entirely at their own risk. Members will be expected to offer £1.00 per tow for this service.
- 18: At the expiration of a rally, members caravans/motorhomes must be removed from the site unless prior arrangements have been made with the landowner by the Rally Marshal, taking due awareness of any planning regulations.
- 19: Members are advised to carry their medical cards.
- <u>20:</u> All visitors must report to the Rally Marshal upon arrival at the rally site.
- <u>21:</u> Proposed raffles MUST receive prior permission from the Committee.
- <u>22:</u> Where a licensed bar is provided at a social event members are NOT allowed to take their own drinks.

- 23: Children of 16 years of age and over will be classed as adults at social events.
- <u>24:</u> Social events organised by Marshals shall be for members and their families attending the rally. Visitors to the rally may attend the Social subject to the Marshals discretion. Entertainers and their families are exempt from this rule. This rule does not apply to Christmas and New Year rallies.
- <u>25:</u> Pup tents (2 person) are permitted, one per unit, but **MUST** be sited with the approval and guidance of the Rally Marshal.
- **26:** The use of generators will be restricted to the hours of 10.00am to 8.00pm (for a 2 hour period only in any one day) only when a responsible adult is in attendance. The exception to this rule is on medical grounds and rally events with the agreement of the Rally Marshal. Members using generators should be aware of the disturbance to other ralliers.
- <u>27:</u> Bad behaviour will not be tolerated, and offenders whether adults or children will be asked to leave the venue.
- **28:** Bookings for weekend and holiday rallies must be made 15 working days prior to rally in order to guarantee a rally plaque.
- **29:** Gas heaters in marquees, gazebo's or any canvas structures are not to be permitted due to Carbon Monoxide fumes being emitted & also due to the safety aspect of concentrated heat rising causing localised heating and therefore a fire risk.

It is suggested that electric heaters are used with 1 unit per 3kw feed cable and an RCD breaker is used.

Protect heater from rain, tent fabric etc.; and do not leave unattended.

Any ralliers found to be in breach of any Centre Rule may be reported to the Committee by the Rally Marshal, or other Committee Member. The Committee will then review the matter and agree upon a suitable course of action. These rules are supplementary to the obligation which all members undertake on joining the Club which includes observation of the Caravan Code and the Country Code. In the variance these rules shall apply.

#### RALLY PROGRAMME MEETING.

A Rally Programme Meeting, to which ALL ralliers are invited, will be held on Sunday 17th May 2020 at 10.30am at Willows Farm Warton.

#### CENTRE MENBERSHIP.

On receipt of your Membership Card, complete and return to Club Offices at East Grinstead, a Centre Registration Form. There is a facility on the internet which allows members to join a Centre, renew Centre membership and check Centre registration. The link is from the home page, then Local Groups, into Centre membership. http://www.caravanclub.co.uk/local-groups or alternately you can use the link from the South Staffs website click on Register/Reregister tab @www.southstaffscaravanclub.co.uk

#### CHAIRMAN'S OPEN FORUM.

An open forum, at which members may place any questions or suggestions relative to Centre activities before the Committee will be held on Sunday 17th May at 10.00am at Willows Farm, Warton. Other open forums will be arranged if requested by three full members giving at least six weeks' notice.

#### WINTER FUNCTIONS.

Details of Winter Functions, which are open for members and guests who are not attending an associated rally, may be obtained from our Entertainments Secretary. Please supply a stamped Addressed Envelope.

#### SPORTS EQUIPMENT.

The Centre Sports Equipment is available for the use of members at rallies by prior arrangement with the Equipment Officer.

#### CATERING EQUIPMENT.

Centre Catering Equipment (e.g. Water Boilers, Porringers, Jugs, Trays, etc) is available for the use of members at rallies by prior arrangement with the Centre Catering Secretary.

#### RALLY EQUIPMENT.

Signs, Flags, Markers, P.A Equipment, etc., are available for the use by members at rallies by prior arrangement with the Centre Equipment Secretary. If using the Centre generator, please keep it safe, **LOCK IT UP**.

#### **INSURANCE.**

All persons attending a Rally Event do so entirely at their own risk. No responsibility for persons or property is accepted by the organisers. The South Staffordshire Centre is covered through the Caravan Club Limited against Third Party Claims.

Any rallier found to be in breach on any Centre Rule may be reported to the Committee by the Rally Marshal, or other Committee Member. The Committee will then review the matter and agree upon a suitable course of action. These rules are supplementary to the obligation which all member undertake on joining the Club which includes observation of the Caravan Code and the Country Code. In the variance these rules shall apply.

#### **COMPETITION RULES**

#### FISHING COMPETITION

- 1: All competitors over 12 years must hold a valid Environments Agency rod licence and produce it to the Sports Officer on request.
- 2: Members wishing to fish MUST fill in and return a booking form (available from the Sports Officer) with full payment to the Sports Officer 7 days prior to the event.
- **3:** Any member fishing must be staying in a caravan on the rally for a minimum of one night.
- **4:** All adults and teenagers **MUST** hook and land their own fish; assistance may be given to children.
- 5: All rules of the pool must be adhered to.
- 6: Lead shot must not be used.
- 7: Barbless hooks to be used at all times.
- 8: Trophies awarded:-GENTLEMAN, LADY, TEENAGER, CHILD and HEAVIEST FISH.

#### **Hints For New Ralliers**

#### To attend a rally.

- 1: Complete in full the details requested on the rally booking form.
- 2: Deliver the completed form to the Rally Marshal either by post or by hand at least two full weeks before the start of the rally (some rallies require more notice).

- **8:** Centre rules require a minimum distance of 6 meters between the sidewall of adjacent caravans. Unless site space is severely limited ralliers are allocated a larger pitch space than is necessary to comply with this rule.
- **9:** Members are allowed to reserve **one space** for a friend a chair or bucket placed on the pitch indicates such a reservation.
- **10:** Members are required to place a fire bucket outside their caravan.



## GENERAL LETTERS TO CENTRES SECTION 3, ANNEX D 1st September 2014 PITCH SPACING AT RALLIES.

A minimum spacing between facing walls of adjacent motorhomes and caravans (the unit) of 6 metres is required. There must also be 3 metres clear between outfits, where an outfit is taken to mean and include the unit, an awning, pup tent and a car. Whilst there is no spacing restriction with regard to rally field boundaries, e.g. fences, trees and hedges, the siting of outfits must not be allowed to interfere with the activities of local people, their privacy or enjoyment of their property.

This diagram is reproduced from the Natural England Guide to 'Camping and Touring Caravan Exemption Certificates'.




