Chris's Cooking Corner

Slow Cooker Corned Beef Hash Ingredients 450g Corned Beef, Chopped

450g Potatoes, Chopped

1 onion Chopped

2 tbsp. extra virgin Olive Oil

2 tbsp. Worcestershire Sauce

1 tsp. Garlic Powder

1 tsp. Dried Oregano

1 tbsp. Chopped Parsley, plus more for garnish

Directions

Line a slow cooker with foil & spray with cooking oil Place all ingredients into slow cooker, mix together gently and cook on high for approx 4 hours until potatoes are cooked.

To speed up cooking time par boil the potatoes and onion first.

If you're scared of spiders, you can deter them from coming into your home by concocting a spider repelling brew!

Mix pine, peppermint and other essential oils with water, put the liquid into a spray bottle, then spray doors and windows on the outside.




