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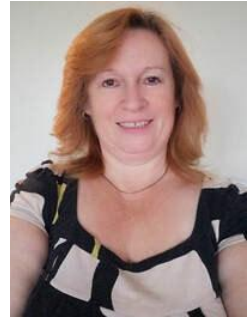

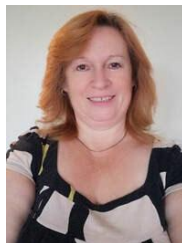

## 2024 Charity Report

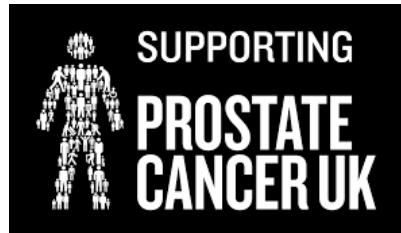
Due to the generosity of the South Staffs Centre members and visitors during 2023/24 we were able to raise £351.30 to present to Prostate Cancer UK.

# Annual General Meeting

The 59th Annual General Meeting of the South Staffs Centre of the Caravan & Motorhome Club will be held at Offley Hay Hall, 2 Mere Rise, Copmere End, Stafford, ST21 6HH on Saturday 4th October 2025 at 10.00am.

Notice of motions signed by the proposer and seconder must be in the hands of the Secretary 35 days before the meeting.

Any nominations for our Centre Charity for the coming year must be received by the centre secretary not later than 14 days prior to the meeting.

Nominations for Office or Committee in writing and signed by the proposer and seconder must be received by the secretary not later than 14 days prior to the meeting, i.e. 10.00am Saturday 20th September 2025. Nomination forms are printed in the Centre brochure or may be obtained from the Secretary.

The principal business to be transacted will be:

1. Apologies for Absence
2. Acceptance of the Minutes of the previous Meeting
3. The Chairman's Report
4. The Treasurer's Report
5. To elect Officers and Members of the Committee
6. To Appoint Centre Auditors
7. To consider propositions
8. To elect by voting the Centre Charity for the year
9. Any other Business

Current Membership Cards must be shown before voting slips can be given to those members who have complied with Centre Rules 4(b) and 6(g). Copies of the 2024 A.G.M. Minutes and Balance Sheet will be available after 1st September 2025, from the secretary on application and receipt of a C4 S.A.E.

Anyone requiring a large print version of these documents are asked to contact the secretary.

# Committee Criterion Standing Orders

1. The Centre shall be known as the South Staffs Centre of the Caravan and Motorhome Club and shall be governed in accordance with "Centre Rules" as issued from Club Headquarters and published in the Club Handbook. This is supported by "Centre Guidance".
2. Elect from amongst themselves a committee, comprising the centres officers, which must include Chair, Treasurer and Secretary and, if desired, one or more Vice Chair to run the centre on behalf of the registered members.
3. The number of members of the centre committee shall be determined by the Centre Annual General Meeting (AGM) but shall be not less than five or more than 15.
4. The Auditor shall be elected annually and not hold any office or be a member of the committee.
5. No member may be elected to fill more than one of the offices referred to in rule 2.
6. The Centre Committee may fill casual vacancies amongst the Centre Offices and coopt additional members to the Centre Committee to bring up to the number authorised for the time being by the Centre AGM.
7. Sub-Committees may be set up to examine and discuss any matter concerning the business of the Centre and may make recommendations to the full Committee. The Chair and the Secretary must be ex-officio members of any Sub-Committee.
8. The determining body which has the power to reject decisions arrived at by the Centre Committee shall be the Centre Members Annual General Meeting, or any special General Meeting convened for that purpose.
9. Annual General Meetings to be held in October of each year, and Special General Meetings to be convened according to Club By-Laws.
10. Annual General Meetings – Election of Officers and Committee.
  - a. South Staffs Centre Members wishing to stand for Committee must have their proposal form signed by the Proposer and a Secunder, who must be a South Staffs Centre Member and the nominee and handed in to the Secretary not later than fourteen days before the AGM.
  - b. Any full, joint and family member may stand for election as a Committee Member.
  - c. Only a retiring Committee Member may stand for election in the office of: (a) Chair, (b) Secretary, (c) Vice Chair, (d) Treasurer.
  - d. There is no limit to how long a person may stand for re-election in the Office of: (a) Chair, (b) Secretary, (c) Vice Chair, (d) Treasurer.
11. The Centre Committee shall meet as and when necessary and shall be governed by Standing Orders.



12. Notices of Motion: A "Notice of Motion" shall be interpreted by the Committee as a proposition of substance and/or one likely to be controversial thus requiring members to have prior notice of same in accordance with Rules Governing Centre's.
13. The Committee shall be empowered to amend these rules in accordance with any amendment for Rules Governing Centre's as issued by Club Headquarters and any question regarding the interpretation of these rules shall be referred to Club Headquarters whose decision shall be final.

# Centre Rules

1. Any site or part of a site, on which a rally is held, will be for the exclusive use of Caravan & Motorhome Club member's caravans and motorhomes. Attendance at the site and/or payment of the rally fee is acceptance by a member of these rules.
2. Authority for the conduct of a rally is held by the Rally Marshal or his deputy.
3. ALL RALLIES will start at 2.00pm on Friday unless otherwise stated in the Rally Book, or as instructed by the Rally Marshals.
4. All members must report to the Rally Marshal upon arrival at the site before pitching their caravan or motorhome. A member must be prepared to produce their CAMC membership card to the Rally Marshal or their deputy.
5. Each caravan or motorhome and towing vehicle must be placed on the pitch indicated by the Rally Marshal or their deputy.
6. ALL CARAVANS & MOTORHOMES MUST BE PITCHED TO ALLOW AT LEAST 6 METERS FROM THE SIDE WALL OF ONE CARAVAN/MOTORHOME TO THE NEXT. Members violating this rule will be asked to move. Motor vehicles should be parked on the off side of the caravan. This rule minimises fire hazard and respects a neighbour's pitch. All caravans and motorhomes must carry a fire extinguisher. A fire bucket containing water must be displayed at the front of the outfit.
7. You may not reserve more than one pitch unless approved, in advance, by the Rally Marshal.
8. THE SPEED LIMIT ON THE RALLY FIELD IS WALKING PACE OR FIVE MILES AN HOUR. Only fully licensed drivers are allowed to drive on the rally site.
9. Dogs must be on leads or tethered on a lead not exceeding eight feet in length and tethered not more than two feet from any part of the caravan/motorhome. All dogs must be exercised away from the caravans/motorhomes. Please ensure you clean up after your dog. Well behaved animals are usually allowed in halls (with hall owners permission) and shelters when no food is being served. Rally Marshals may ask you to leave if there becomes a valid problem
10. Members must make provision to store and take home all dry and wet refuse. Empty only chemical toilets in the pit provided. Chemical toilets must not be filled or washed out near drinking water supplies.
11. Noise must be kept to a reasonable minimum and cease at 11pm. Music and parties must not disturb neighbouring members.
12. The use of guns, catapults and all weapons is prohibited.
13. Riding bicycles & scooters, flying kites and model aircraft, as well as ball games is not permitted among or close to caravans/motorhomes. Parents will be held responsible for any damaged incurred.

14. Drones are banned from the rally field and any centre event also from any club site without prior agreement from Head Office. Any unauthorised use by members will face disciplinary action.
15. To book on a rally:
  - (a) Book directly through our fully secure web site, by clicking on the relevant rally, then click on the "book now" button. The booking form will display and should be completed and submitted. The Marshal will acknowledge your booking and for some rallies where a deposit is required, advise the amount to be forwarded to secure the booking.
  - (b) Deliver a completed booking slip to the Rally Marshal either by post or by hand.
16. Rally Booking Terms and Conditions. Members who cancel or do not arrive must pay £2 for weekend rallies or a calculated amount to cover any costs incurred prior to the rally. This includes social tickets if they cannot be sold to other ralliers on a waiting list. This will be collected from members on subsequent rallies.
  - (a) If you cancel a rally due to bereavement of a family member the centre will reimburse a full refund.
  - (b) Any booked non-attendance may be reimbursed either all or partial refund, after consideration by the Committee, for exceptional circumstances only. Applications should be made to the committee by letter only. (this will be paid from Centre funds).
  - (c) If the centre cancels a rally then all money will be refunded.
17. It should be appreciated that for special rallies where food and or entertainment has been provided that the money has already been spent on their behalf and they have accepted to pay any expense incurred on their original booking form.
18. A plain Red or Yellow Flag flown from the flagpole indicates that a Rally Marshal is restricting vehicle movement on the site. Vehicles must not be moved without a marshal's permission. Other Centres including the Caravan Club may use a Yellow Flag.
19. If a tow is accepted, it is on the understanding that the owner or driver of the towing vehicle shall not be held responsible for any damage incurred. Persons accepting a tow from a 4X4 vehicle do so entirely at their own risk. Members will be expected to offer £1.00 per tow for this service.
20. At the end of a rally, members caravans/motorhomes must be removed from the site unless prior arrangements have been made with the landowner by the Rally Marshal, taking due awareness of any planning regulations.
21. Members are advised to carry their medical cards.
22. Proposed raffles MUST receive prior permission from the Committee.

23. Where a licensed bar is provided at a social event members are NOT allowed to take their own drinks.
24. Children of 16 years of age and over will be classed as adults at social events.
25. Social events organised by Marshals shall be for members and their families attending the rally. Visitors to the rally may attend the social subject to the Rally Marshal's discretion. Entertainers and their families are exempt from this rule. This rule does not apply to Christmas and New Year rallies.
26. Pup tents (2 person) are permitted, one per unit, but MUST be sited with the approval and guidance of the Rally Marshal.
27. The use of generators will be restricted to the hours of 10.00am to 8.00pm (for a 2-hour period only in any one day) only when a responsible adult is in attendance. The exception to this rule is on medical grounds and rally events with the agreement of the Rally Marshal. Members using generators should be aware of the disturbance to other ralliers.
28. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated, and offenders whether adults or children will be asked to leave the venue.
29. To guarantee a rally plaque, bookings for weekend and holiday rallies must be made 15 working days prior to rally.
30. Gas heaters in marquees, gazebo's or any canvas structures are not to be permitted due to carbon monoxide fumes being emitted and also due to the safety aspect of concentrated heat rising causing localised heating and therefore a fire risk. It is suggested that electric heaters are used with one unit per 3kw feed cable and an RCD breaker is used. Protect heater from rain, tent fabric etc.; and do not leave unattended.

Any ralliers found to be in breach of any Centre Rule may be reported to the Committee by the Rally Marshal, or other Committee Member. The Committee will then review the matter and agree upon a suitable course of action. These rules are supplementary to the obligation which all members undertake on joining the Club which includes observation of the Caravan Code and the Country Code. In the variance these rules shall apply.



## Renewal Of Your Centre Membership

Your membership number will be requested for all rally bookings and checked on arrival at a rally either via your membership card or the digital version. Please ensure you have yours to hand. **Remember**, when you pay for your membership to the Caravan and Motorhome Club it does not automatically re-affiliate you to the South Staffs Centre. This must be done separately a couple of days after your payment has been made.

Renewing your South Staffs membership costs you nothing but makes a big difference to your centre. The support we get from the Caravan and Motorhome Club depends on membership numbers.

If you require an actual membership card please ask for one otherwise you may not get one, only the digital version.

## Guidelines for Allocating Rallies to Rally Marshals

To avoid disappointment, anyone wishing to Marshall one of our events should:

1. Advise the rally secretary - Tim Handley - as soon as possible - especially where it is a rally you may have run for several years.
2. Contact the rally secretary by phone (07817 955282), and confirm in writing to rallysecretary@southstaffscaravanclub.co.uk
3. If more than one member wishes to marshal the same rally, and advise the rally secretary at the same time, then a cut of playing cards will decide which member will be chosen as the marshal (It will be ace high, high card wins). This is intended to give everyone an equal chance to marshal those rallies in which they are interested.
4. If a potential marshal suggests a new venue which they would like to run, they will be given priority to marshal that event. Again, this should be done in writing as soon as possible.
5. The rally secretary will update the provisional program with the names of those who have advised their intentions in advance.

Thanks for your help and understanding on this matter and I look forward to receiving any ideas for venues for 2026 and onwards.

## Data Protection Clause

Like organ donation - you need to opt out otherwise you agree to be included on our website and in our brochure next year.

'Photography / videography may be taken at our Centre's events and rallies. The Centre and Club may use any photograph(s) and / or video(s) they take that includes you, your party and/or outfit in all and any media, including printed and electronic publications, e.g. websites, or promotional materials, in the advertising of its goods or services. The photograph(s) and / or video(s) may be stored for these purposes as well.

If you do not want to appear in any shots, please advise the organiser if it relates to a specific event, or the centre secretary if for all events. They will do their best to accommodate this and ensure you are able to avoid the area being photographed / filmed.'

Where the Centre submits images including clearly identifiable people for publication, the individuals must have given the Centre permission to take and use images in all and any media by use of this wording.

## South Staffs Caravan Centre Rallies

Please book all rallies by completing the booking form on the website for the relevant rally. Most rallies are paid for on arrival, but holiday rallies may require a deposit or full payment before the event. Details will be on the relevant event page on the website.

### **Cancelling a Booking**

If you are unable to attend a rally, please contact the rally marshals or a member of the committee. You will only be liable for any costs that have been spent on your behalf.

### **Site Fees**

Site fees are correct at the time of publication, but we have no control over changes made by site owners or the government. We will make every effort to ensure correct site fees are shown on the website and these will be updated in there are any changes.

### **Early Arrivals**

Please remember that the Rally Marshals need to have time to set up their own outfit and prepare the rally before you arrive - please adhere to the published rally opening times.

## Safety on Rallies

1. All vehicles are limited to 5 miles an hour. Watch out for children playing.
2. Do not light portable barbecues near caravans or awnings. Beware of the dangers from sparks and sudden changes of wind direction.
3. Carry a suitable fire extinguisher or a fire blanket sited near the door of the caravan. Dry powder extinguishers are more reliable if inverted and shaken smartly. Remember cooking oil is a great fire hazard.
4. Children should never be left alone in the unit.
5. Catalytic converters – can igniting the grass.
6. Where Rally Officers have set out site pegs, park with the offside corner as near to the peg as possible, unless told to do otherwise.

## Have You Been On A Rally Yet?

### **If not, then read on and give it a try!**

It is simply a gathering of Caravan & Motorhome Club members, for a weekend or holiday, to promote friendship and pursue many pleasures, pastimes and sports, in a light-hearted manner and have some fun along the way. You should never feel obliged to join in anything which does not interest you.

The rally marshal is an ordinary member who has volunteered to organise and run the Rally. This usually includes arranging the Rally with the landowner, signing the approach to the rally field and organising competitions and entertainment for all ages. This may include a social on the Saturday evening which is a family event with games for the children and dancing for all ages or a party in the field in Summer with sporting and fund raising events and walks throughout the season. Arrangements for a water supply and facilities for the disposal of wastewater and toilet emptying will be made. The Rally start times are printed in the Rally Brochure, so please do not arrive before that time; this is to allow the marshal sufficient time to prepare.

On arrival, drive up to the rally marshal's van. Please advise the rally marshal that this is your first rally. You will be handed an envelope containing the rally programme of activities and advice on local amenities, restrictions and arrangements for wastewater etc. At the start and end of the Rally there is a "round the flag". This is where ralliers gather at the marshal's van to enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and meet other ralliers. You will gain information about the rally and any forthcoming events.

All you need in addition to items you would normally expect to take on a commercial site, is your own toilet together with a water container and a waste bin for dry waste which you to take home with you. Simple wooden wedges and blocks are sometimes required for sloping fields. The field is marked out to ensure ample spacing between caravans and a pleasing appearance.

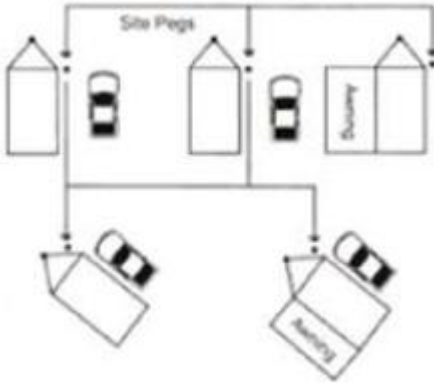
Please read the rules in this rally book and make sure the other members of your family are aware of what is expected of them.



# General Rally Information

## Spacing of Units at Rallies

Where Rally Marshalls have set site pegs units should be parked with the front offside corner as near to the peg as possible, unless told to do otherwise



There **MUST** be a minimum space left clear of 3 metres (10 feet) between adjoining units in any direction. It is recommended that 6 metres (20 feet) is left between facing walls of adjacent caravans, while still ensuring that a minimum of 3 metres (10 feet) is left clear between adjacent units. A 20-foot space allows a car to be parked in the space alongside each unit without encroaching on the 10 foot minimum clear space that has to be kept. If an awning or sun canopy is

erected the space between facing walls of adjacent caravans will need to be greater than 6 metres (20 feet) to accommodate a car, caravan, awning and a 3 metre (10 foot) space. This minimum 3 metre (10 foot) space must be left clear throughout the rally and must not be encroached upon. This means that awnings, canopies, tarpaulins or windbreaks must not be used to join caravans together. A minimum distance of 4 metres (13 feet) between lines should be allowed for easy access of emergency vehicles.

## Rally Start Time

Rallies are governed by The Caravan & Motorhome Club rules and can only start when the designated marshals are in attendance. A list of stewards is given to The Caravan & Motorhome Club each year in the form of the rally book details, to comply with insurance requirements.

Any member wishing to arrive at a rally before the official start time must check with the stewards to ensure that the venue is open. In many cases stewards have to attend work prior to the rally and therefore must be given time to set up their rally and should not be pressurised.

## Rally Deposit Refunds

If a member is unable to attend a rally and would like a refund then they must contact the Secretary within 28 days of the rally.

## Checking with Landowners

Rally marshals must get in touch with landowners at least four weeks prior to the rally, to finalise details. There have had instances where rallies have not

been in the landowner's diary despite correct paperwork being held by the Centre. At the same time, please confirm the day/time that you as stewards would be allowed to arrive.

## Site Fees

Site Fees are correct at the time of going to press. Your committee have no control over changes made by the site owners or the Government. Where site fees are shown they are inclusive of 20% VAT. Generally social events carry an additional cost.

## Catering Equipment

Centre Catering Equipment (e.g. Water Boilers, Porringers, Jugs, Trays, etc) are available for the use of members at rallies by prior arrangement with the Centre. Please contact the Secretary.

## Rally Equipment

Signs, Flags, Markers, etc., is available for the use by members at rallies by prior arrangement with the Centre. If using the Centre generator, please keep it safe, LOCK IT UP.

## Insurance

All persons attending a Rally Event do so entirely at their own risk . No responsibility for persons or property is accepted by the organisers. The South Staffordshire Centre is covered through the Caravan Club Limited against Third Party Claims.

## Finding the site.

1. Brief instructions are given in the Rally Book. This includes the address and postcode. As you near the site look out for our SSCC rally signs (A yellow sign with SSCC).
2. Confirm directions with a map before setting out.

1. Ask a member of our committee for a registration sheet or download a copy from our website using [this link](#).
2. At every South Staffs Weekend Rally you attend, ask the marshal of that rally to sign and date it for you.
3. When you have attended four South Staffs weekend rallies and got your form signed for each of them, your fifth weekend rally is free up to the value of £15.00. Bring along your form to the fifth rally as payment / part payment. HAPPY RALLYING.



## **Our Speed Limit**

We enforce a 5 MPH Maximum Speed Limit on our Rallies. Please be aware of children running between Caravans and Motorhomes

## **Adverse Weather**

To avoid undue damage to the site and its entrance in bad weather, Marshalls will advise of any precautions made to ensure everyone's safety. On occasion this may include restricting movement on the site. Please follow any advice you are given. On some occasions it may be necessary to park away from your unit if the ground is unusually wet.

## **Dogs on Rallies**

We welcome well behaved dogs on our rallies. Please ensure your dog is kept on a lead less than 2m long at all times. If tethered at your unit, the tether point must be central to your unit with a lead less than 2m. The tether must not be at the front of your unit.

Dogs are not allowed into organised social events whilst food is being consumed unless they are register assistance dogs.

Members must remove any droppings left by their pets.

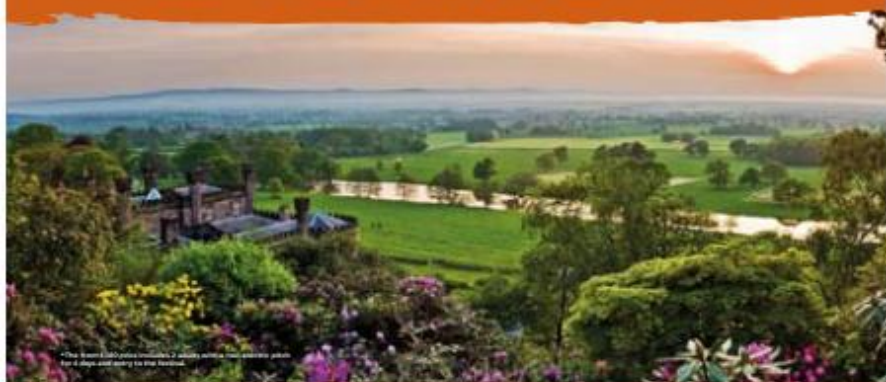
